General Halachot (page numbers are for the Artscroll siddur)

- Borchu and Kaddish are not recited.
- On the 2nd Day of Shavuot Yizkor (page 810) can be recited at home with Av HaRachamim (p. 454).

Shabbat, June 4th Leil Shavuot

- Ma'ariv (p. 330) say Vayidabeir instead of V'shomru before Yom Tov Amidah (p. 336 then p. 660), insert Vatodieynu in Amidah (p. 664 grey box). Aleinu.
- Candle lighting time and kiddush AFTER 9:07 pm.
- "Yaknehaz" in kiddush – we add a section for Havdalah and we take 1 or 2 Yom Tov candles for the blessing over the candle. You may use the lights in your home that are already turned on for this blessing if necessary.
 - Kiddush for Shalosh Regalim (p. 658)
 - It is customary to remain awake and study Torah until dawn.

Sunday June 5th - 1st Day of Shavuot

 - Maftir Bamidbar 28:26-31 (p. 968)
 - Haftarah: Yechezkel 1:1-28 (p. 968)
