General Halachot (page numbers are for the complete Artscroll Machzor for Yom Kippur)

- Borchu, Kaddish, Kedusha, Chazarat HaShatz, and the Thirteen Attributes of God during Selichot are not recited without a minyan. You may recite the 13 attributes as read from Torah with 'trope' (cantillation).
- Piyyutim are not essential to the prayer service and are omitted, but one may add them as desired.
 - Torah service is omitted, but you may read the Torah sections from a machzor or a chumash.

Tuesday October 4 - Erev and Leil Yom Kippur

- Kaparot (p. 2-4)
- Mincha with viduy before the Seudat Hamafseket (final meal before Yom Kippur) (pages. 6-28)
- Seudat Hamafseket (final meal before fast): should be eaten with bread. Must finish before 6:38 pm
- Light candles with shehecheyanu before 6:38
- It is preferable to start Yom Kippur at least 3 minutes before Sunset **6:38 PM** (Tosefet Yom Kippur)
- Declaration of forgiveness in Tefila Zaka (p. 40)
- Kol Nidrei (p.58), Shehechiyanu (p. 60) recited by everyone who did not say it during candle lighting.
- **Ma'ariv**: (p. 66) Birchot kriat Shema & Shema, Ki Bayom (p. 76), Amida (p. 78-98), Selichot (p. 102-142) Thirteen Attributes of God during Selichot are not recited without a minyan. You may recite the 13 attributes as read from Torah with 'trope' (cantillation).
- Avinu Malkeinu (p. 144-148) Aleinu (p. 152), L'Dovid (p. 156)

Wednesday October 5 Yom Kippur Day

- Shacharit: Birchot Hashachar (p. 246-252), Shir shel yom (p. 236) and l'Dovid (p. 244), Pesukei d'Zimra (p. 282-322), Birchot kriat Shema & Shema (p. 326, 330-334 top section, 336, 342-350), Amida (p. 350-364), Avinu Malkeinu (p. 436-438), Torah Reading: Vayikra 16:1-34 (p. 452-456), Maftir Bamidbar 29:7-11 (p. 458-460), Haftorah Yishayahu 57:14-58:14 (p. 462-464), Yizkor (p. 470-476)
